Pre-requisites:

City of Lake Oswego residents in grades 9-12; or attend Lakeridge High School or Lake Oswego High School.

Youth Action Council members must meet the following requirements:

- Attend 9 monthly meetings (schedule attached) from September-June
- Provide 35 hours of volunteer service with YAC during the school year
- Work on designated YAC sub-committees to plan, promote and implement community activities within Lake Oswego
