

Resource Conservation Protection Area (RCPA) and Habitat Benefit Area (HBA) Determination

A Resource Conservation (RC) Protection Area is a portion of a delineated RC District (tree grove) that is required to be identified and protected from development prior to obtaining a building permit or a major or minor development permit on a property containing an RC District. Similarly, a Protection Area shall be established where a property owner elects to use the Habitat Benefit Area (HBA) incentives of LOC 50.05.010.7.
