

Surveying

Surveying is the science of making precise measurements of the Earth's surface with the aid of complex optical and electronic instruments. Surveying and mapping is handled by the Engineering Planning Division and is of vital importance for exploration, preservation of natural resources, and land development within Lake Oswego.

The [Geographic Information Services \(GIS\) program](#) is an integral part of the Surveying and Mapping Division. It utilizes an integrated system of computer hardware and software designed to efficiently manage data related to positions on the Earth's surface.
