

About the Historic Resources Advisory Board

The Historic Resources Advisory Board is an eight-member (including one youth member) citizen advisory body appointed by the City Council. It meets each month to promote and foster the historic, educational, architectural, cultural, economic, and general welfare of the public through the identification, preservation, restoration, and protection of those structures, sites, objects, and districts of historic and cultural interest within the city.

Meetings are held the second Wednesday of every month at City Hall, 380 A Avenue, in the Municipal Courtroom (first floor), generally from 7:00 pm to 9:00 pm. Meeting time, date, and location are subject to change. Please contact staff at (503) 635-0290 to confirm meeting details.
