A volunteer Notary Public is available to notarize your documents at the Lake Oswego Public Library, 706 Fourth Street, on **Saturdays, from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m.** There is no cost for this service. **Please arrive early as the notary work needs to be COMPLETED by 1 p.m. (The Notary Public will determine if the work can be completed by 1 p.m.)**

The Notary Public can certify or attest to a maximum of four copies per visit.
