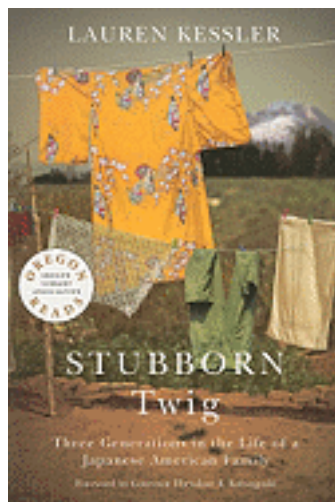


2009 - Stubborn Twig
