A native of San Francisco, Carlile grew up in the Pacific Northwest. His poems have appeared in *American Poetry Review*, *Poetry*, *Shenandoah*, *Southern Poetry Review*, and numerous other journals. Carlile is the author of four published collections of poetry. He will share his memories of William Stafford and discuss Stafford's influence on his own poetry. Participants are encouraged to bring a favorite Stafford poem to read.
