What is Project Alert?

A program providing a daily call to participants during times of bad weather or community emergency and to provide assistance as needed.

Who Operates Project Alert?

The Adult Community Center, in conjunction with the Lake Oswego Police and Fire Departments, developed the program for older adults with a Lake Oswego address. When the program is activated, Adult Center volunteers make daily calls to each registered participant. Special needs and concerns are relayed to Center staff for follow-up.

When?

Project Alert operates only during times of community emergency, such as prolonged heat, ice, snow storms, wind storms, power outages, etc.
