How to get to us:



The Community Gardens

Luscher Farm offers Lake Oswego residents the opportunity to grow their own flowers and vegetables at our community gardens!

Currently, the Community Gardens at Luscher Farm rents around 180 garden plots and hosts a lottery each December to assign empty garden beds. Rental fees are on an annual basis and can be renewed each year.

Gardeners are provided with tools, water, fertilizer and advice (if requested) and are required to complete four work hours during the year towards the garden's upkeep. It's a great way to get exercise, eat healthy food, work together on a multi-generational family project and meet other people with common interests.
