2016 FIELD GROUND RULES

GEORGE ROGERS PARK:

- Balls hit on the fly over the fence in right field will be ruled a homerun.
- Balls rolling or bouncing through fence opening in right field will be a ground rule double.
- Balls hit on the fly, rolling or bouncing into center and right center field bushes will be homeruns.
(a ball hit into the bushes on the fly is considered a home run whether caught or not.)
- Balls hit on the fly or rolling into anything past the left field 3rd base dugout fence (near restrooms) will be ruled a homerun.
- Everywhere else is live.

Note: Please instruct your players to be careful and communicate with each other when tracking balls into right field, as the ground slopes quickly. Also take care when entering bushes in center and left as it also drops off abruptly.

LAKE OSWEGO JR. HIGH

- Balls hit on the fly, rolling or bouncing into the trees in right and left fields will be ruled homeruns.
- Everywhere else is live.

LAKERIDGE JR. HIGH

- Fields are set up back to back so please do not interfere with a ball that enters your field, as it is still live on the other.
- The umpire will call an immediate dead ball if the ball from the other field enters your field of play and poses an immediate threat to any player. A dead ball call will result in re-setting back to pitch count before interference occurred.
- Field #1: Balls hit on the fly, rolling or bouncing into the trees in left or left/center field (Field #1) will be ruled homeruns.
- Everywhere else is live.

Note: Please instruct your players to be careful and communicate with each other to avoid injury.

WESTLAKE PARK

- Balls hit on the fly over short fence in right field and left field fence or if it rolls or bounces through left field gate will be ruled homeruns.
- Everywhere else is live.
