Interesting Facts About Millennium Plaza Park

The park opened on December 28, 1999 in anticipation of the new millennium and was instrumental in the revitalization of downtown LO.

The pergola is named after former City Manager Douglas J. Schmitz, who worked for the city from 1992 to 2007.

A time capsule was buried in the park in 2010 to commemorate the City's Centennial celebration.

In 2010, the bosque, a small grove of Mt. Fuji cherry trees, a beautiful water feature and new ADA accessibility to Headlee Walkway were added. The entire lower plaza was also added, marking the completion of the Millennium Plaza Park project.

The park is often referred to as "the City's living room."

The park hosts weekly, Saturday Farmers' Markets from mid-May through mid-October, Fourth of July and other holiday celebrations, Thursday movies in the park in August, and Sunday Moonlight & Music concerts in July and August.

There are 196 pavers per 10 square feet in the upper and lower plazas.


