

Making A Reservation

When may Roehr Park be reserved?

Applications will be taken starting January 2nd for the current year and the park may only be reserved from March 1st up until Sept 30th of the current year.

Reservations must be made a minimum of 30 days in advance. However, if there are no supplemental documents required, reservations may be accepted less than 30 days in advance, on a case by case basis. Reservations are scheduled between 9am-2:30pm or 3:30-9pm, Monday-Sunday. If the reservation is for a major event, only one is allowed per day between 9am-10pm.

How may I reserve Roehr Park?

1. Contact Parks & Recreation to confirm availability.
2. Complete and submit the park application.
3. To secure the date you have requested, the refundable deposit, processing and cleaning fees must be paid at the time the application is submitted.
4. The hourly park usage fee and any supplemental documents must be submitted, no less than, 30 days prior to the reservation date.

How much does it cost to reserve Roehr Park?

Application Processing Fee: \$25 (*non-refundable*)

Cleaning Fee: \$50 (*non-refundable*)

Refundable Deposit: \$500

Amphitheater Rental Rate: (*depends on type of event*)

\$50/ hour - Generates NO sales.

\$100/ hour - Open to public, generates sales.

\$300/hour - Closed to public, generates sales.

Viewing Dolphin Rental Rate: (*depends on type of event*)

\$35/hour—Generates NO sales

\$70/hour—Open to public, generates sales

\$210/hour—Closed to public, generates sales

What if I must cancel, make changes or it rains?

Cancellations received more than 30 days before the reservation date, will receive a refund of all fees, minus the non-refundable \$25 processing fee. If the cancellation occurs less than 30 days in advance, 20% of the park usage fee will be deducted before the refund is issued. Reservation changes made 30 days or less from the original date will be charged 10% of the park usage fee. We will not accommodate any minor changes to the reservation with less than 7 days notice.

We do not honor cancellations due to inclement weather; however the refundable deposit will be refunded.



Important Information

The City of Lake Oswego, through the Parks and Recreation Department, strives to protect the rights of other park users, neighbors, and the park environment. Please assist us in making your park visit a great experience by following these city ordinances and/or guidelines.

- ⊛ Possession/consumption of alcohol is limited to beer and wine only, and must be served in a designated, monitored area and can only be served in conjunction with a park reservation.
- ⊛ Alcohol must be served by an OLCC licensed caterer and/or an OLCC permitted server. A City of Lake Oswego Alcohol Permit must be completed and approved by the City.
- ⊛ Park equipment and furniture must remain within the confines of the reserved area and returned to their original location after the event.
- ⊛ No motorized vehicles are allowed in the park or beyond marked parking areas.
- ⊛ It is unlawful for any person to use fireworks, firecrackers, or explosives of any kind in the park.
- ⊛ Dogs must be on a leash. The City of Lake Oswego has a "pooper scooper" law.
- ⊛ Portable barbecues may be used in conjunction with an approved reservation. Coals and grease must be safely removed from park by user and may not be dumped in trash receptacles. A protective surface under barbecues is required.
- ⊛ Bring your permit with you; without this your reservation cannot be enforced.
- ⊛ The events of your reservation must be contained to the area reserved. The remainder of the park is still available to the public.

Roehr Park


Roehr Park located off Foothills Road and on Oswego Point Drive was dedicated July 1, 1992. One of five waterfront parks, this 7.5 acre site offers an amphitheater, viewing dolphin, excursion dock, and a scenic, paved trail that meanders along the beautiful Willamette River.

The newly decked viewing dolphin accommodates up to 10 round, 5 feet in diameter tables and affords fabulous up river and down river views.



Park Amenities:

- ★ 4 electrical outlets in Amphitheater area (110v)
- ★ 1 electrical outlet in Amphitheater area (220v)
- ★ 2 drinking fountains by restrooms
- ★ Handicap accessible
- ★ 200 capacity limit
- ★ Recycling and garbage receptacles
- ★ Large Parking Lot
- ★ 4 movable park benches



Dolphin Amenities:

- ★ 3 electrical outlets (110v)
- ★ 100 capacity limit
- ★ 4 lamp posts in Dolphin area
- ★ Wheelchair accessible
